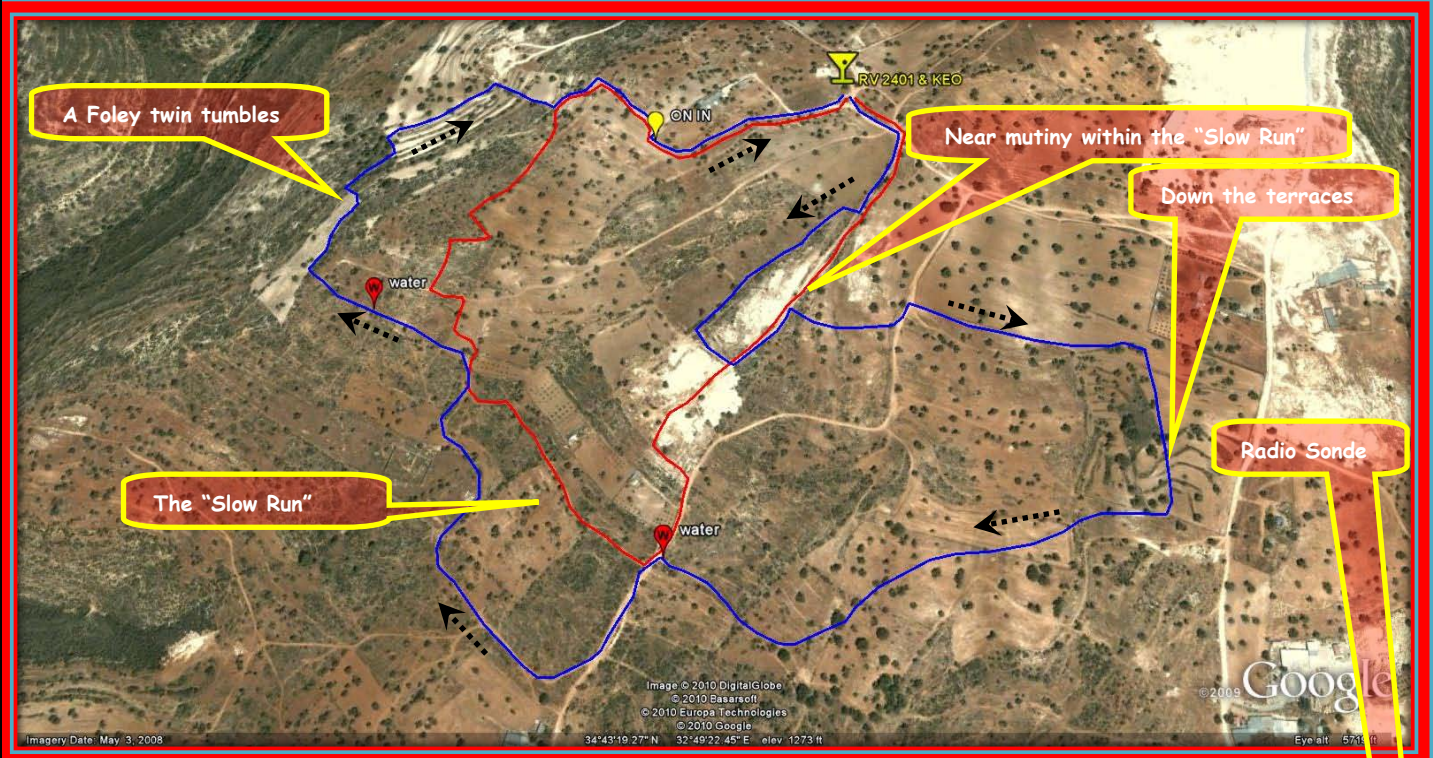

On Pres', Son of Jack, some Senior Hashers and a couple of Near Mutineers, pausing at Check 4 on the Slow Run.



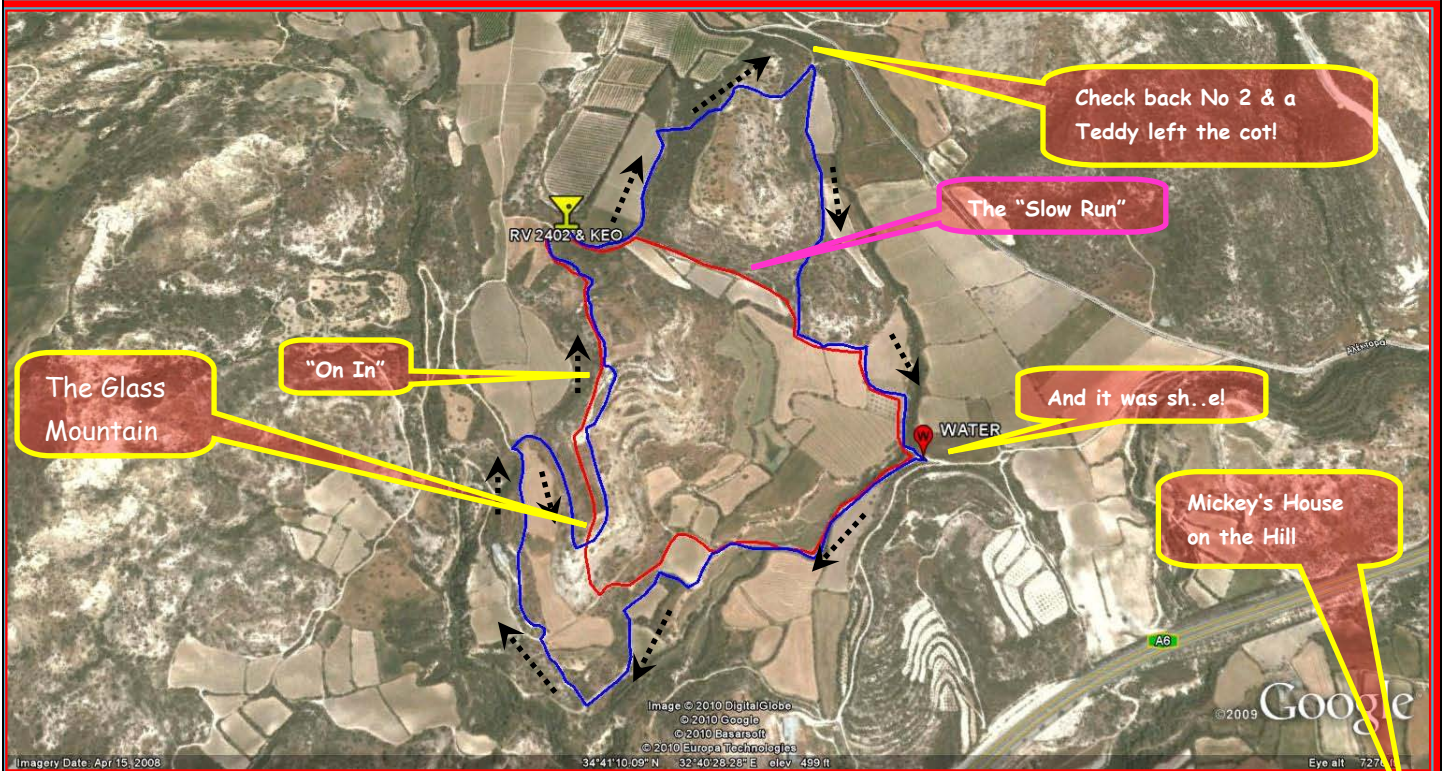

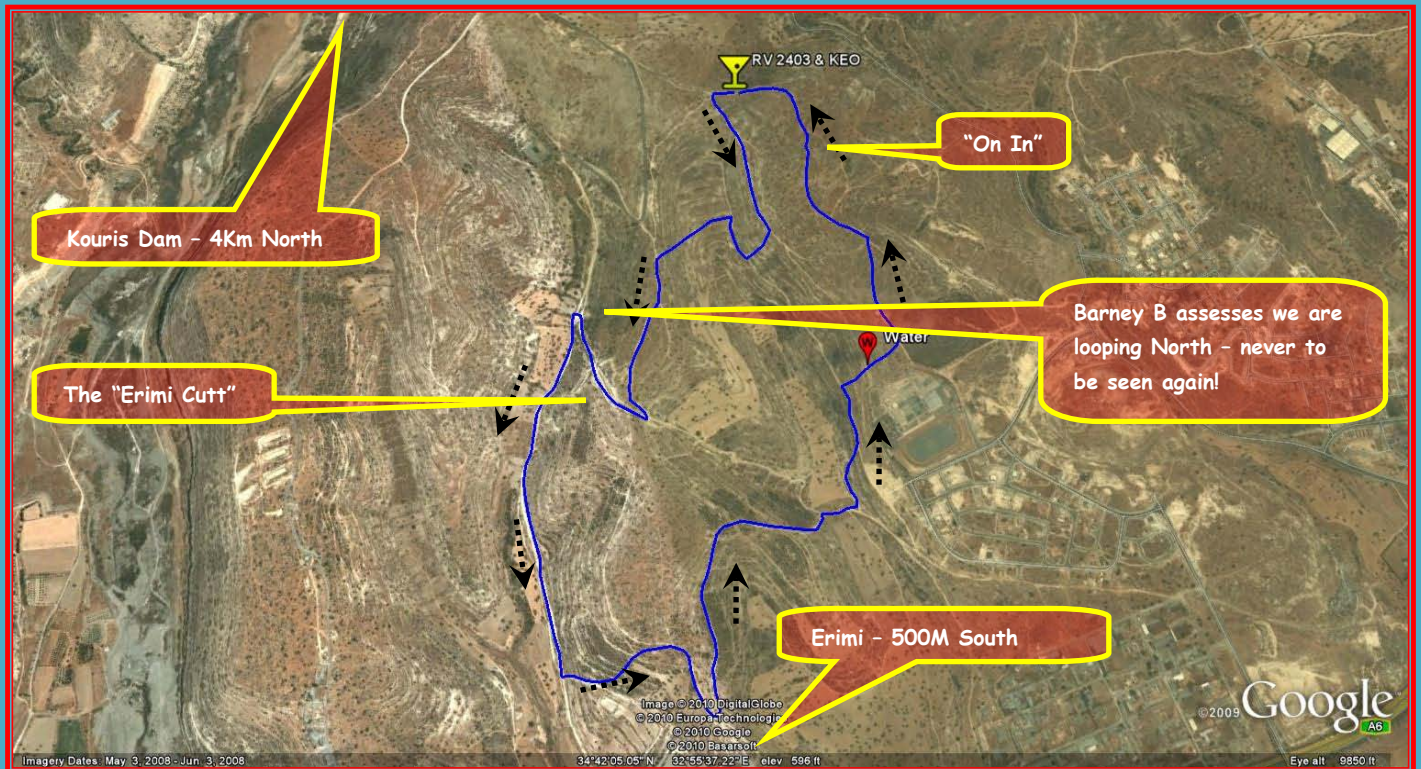

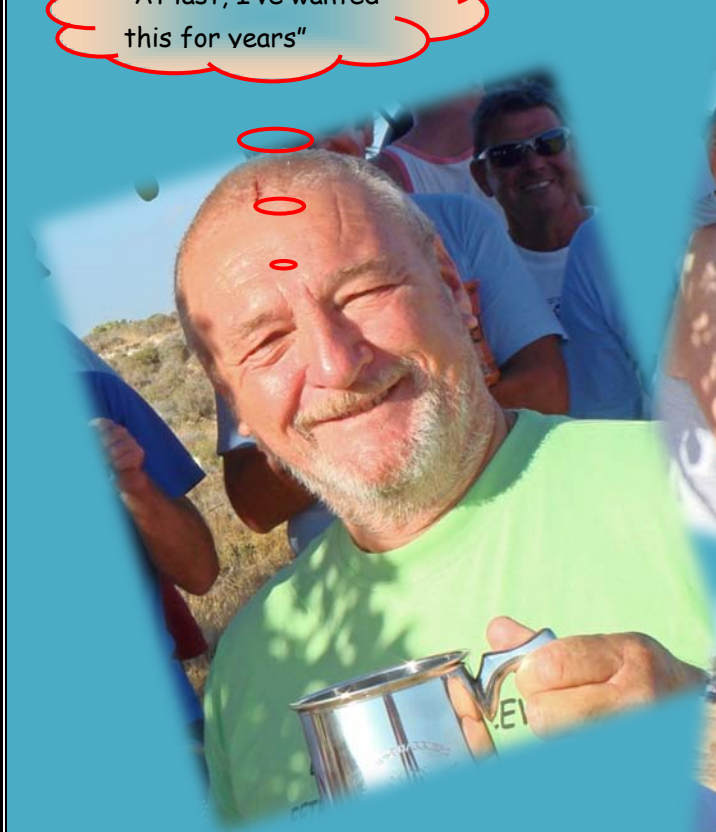
