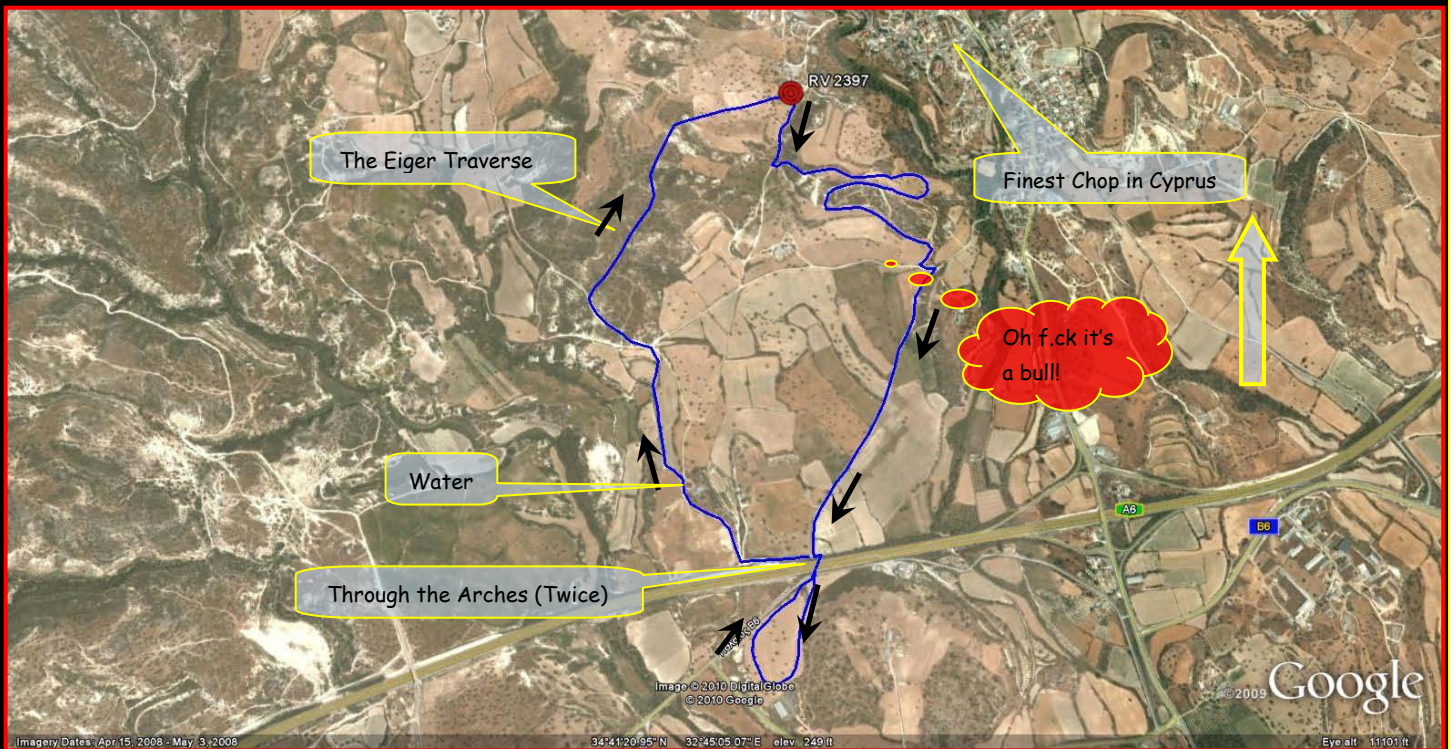
No doubt there will be changes in store, but we hope these will bring further enjoyment of the entertainment that EH3 has had on offer for the past 43 years!

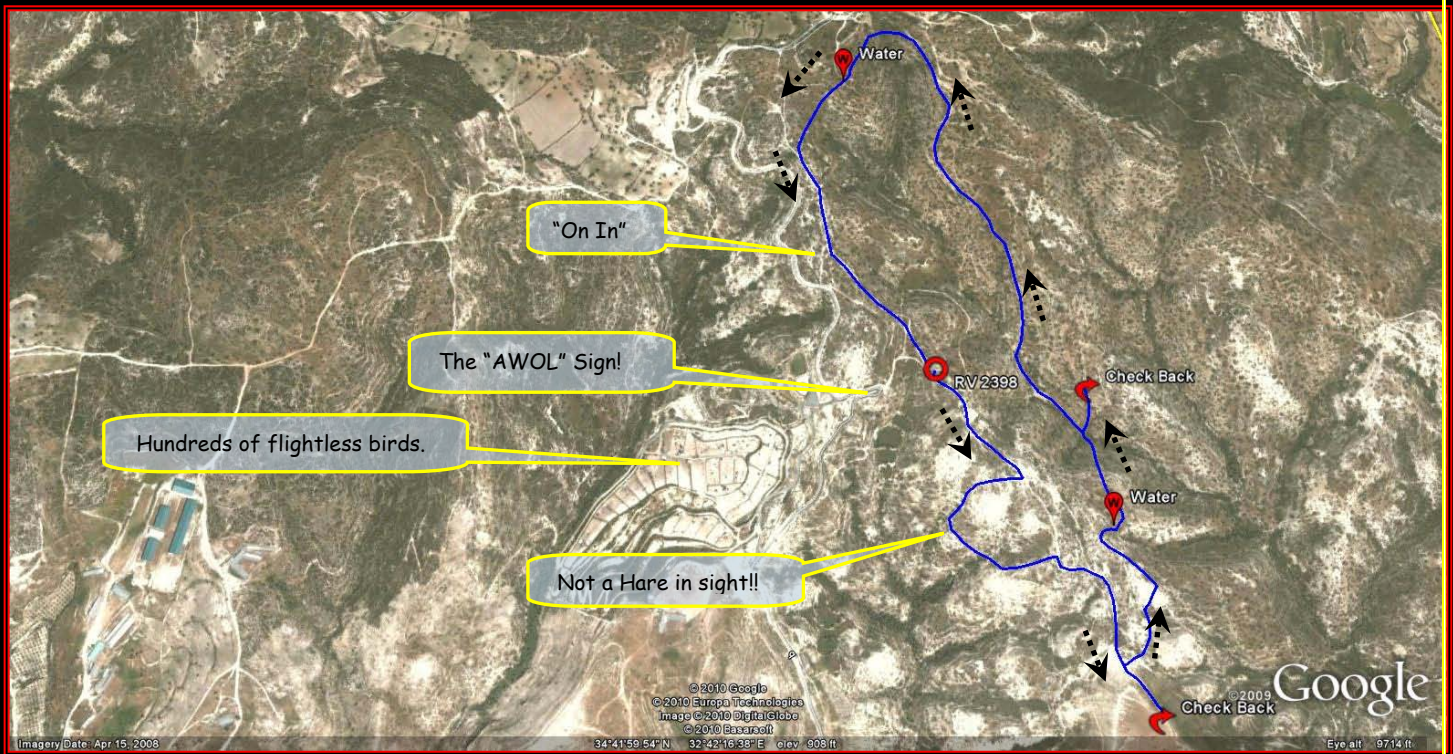

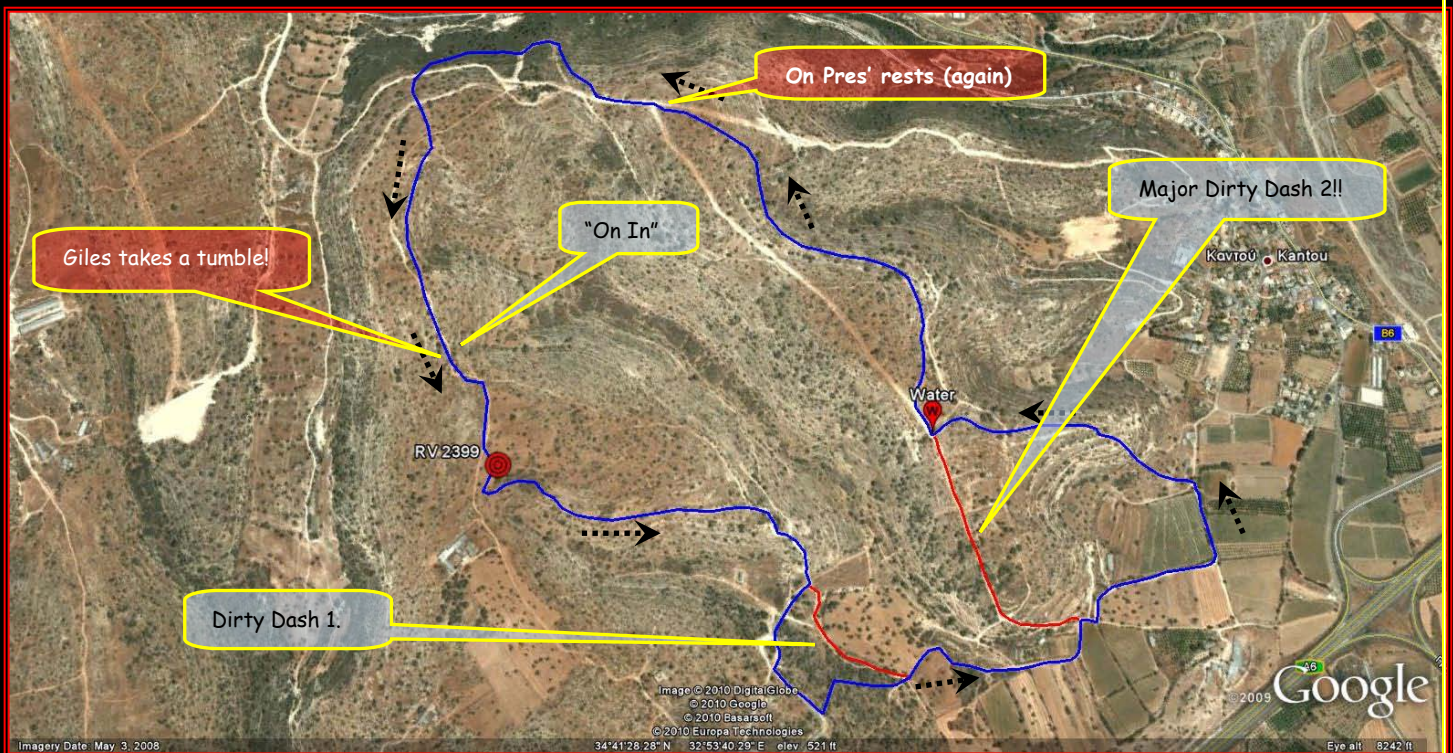
