He became Hash Words and revived that publication that had previously fallen into stagnation. HRH will be sadly missed and many EH3 members marked his memory by their attendance at his funeral at Dhekelia Military Cemetery. His wife Jackie, remains in our thoughts.

The festive season began with a very successful Christmas Bash at the Hill View and our plans now turn to the traditional Open Boxing Day Hash and the New Years Day Brighton Shiverers Swim and Run ... always the very best way to bring in the New Year, Hashing style.

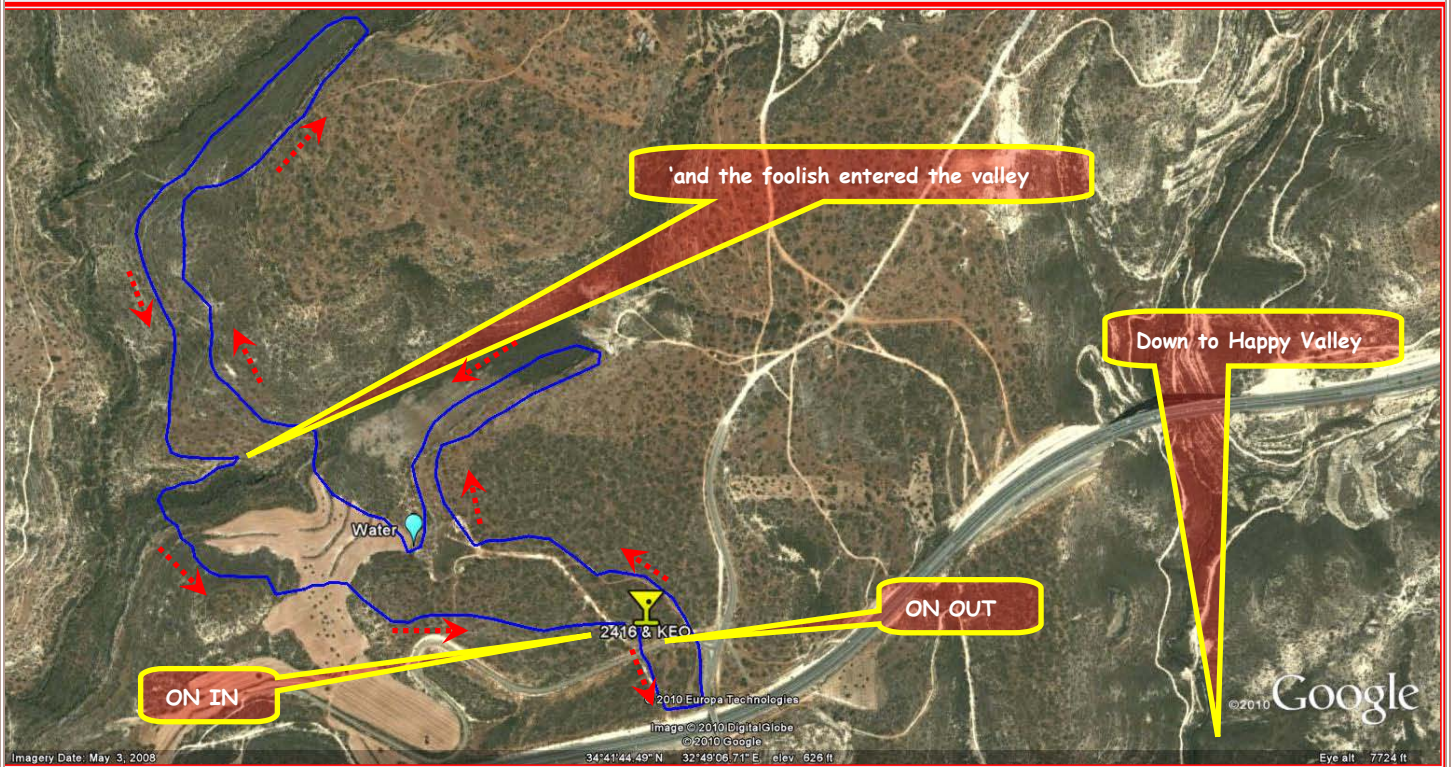

MISSIVE FROM 'WORDS'

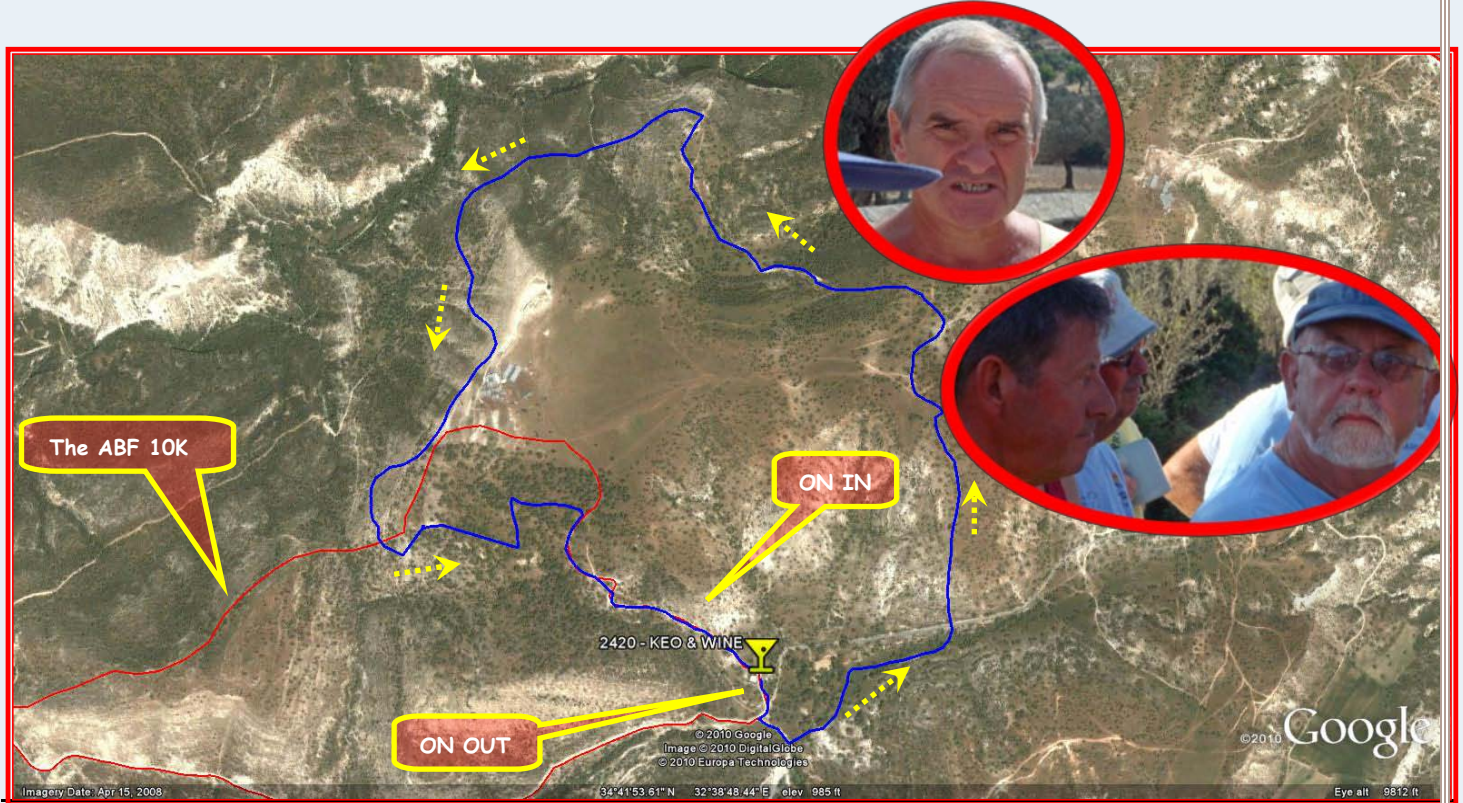
Somewhere about Run 2418 a distressing and painful incident occurred in the 'House of Words' or 'Hoggies Howf'.



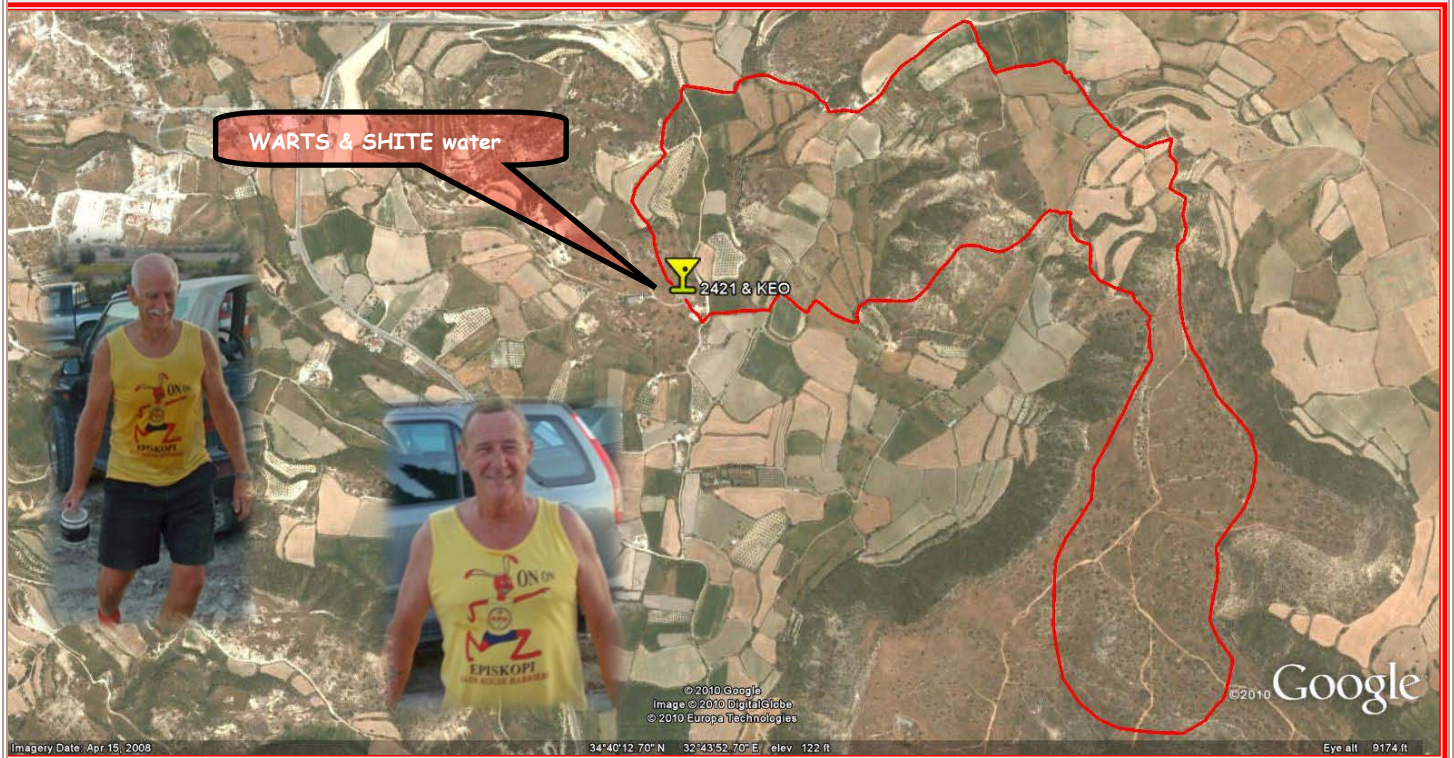

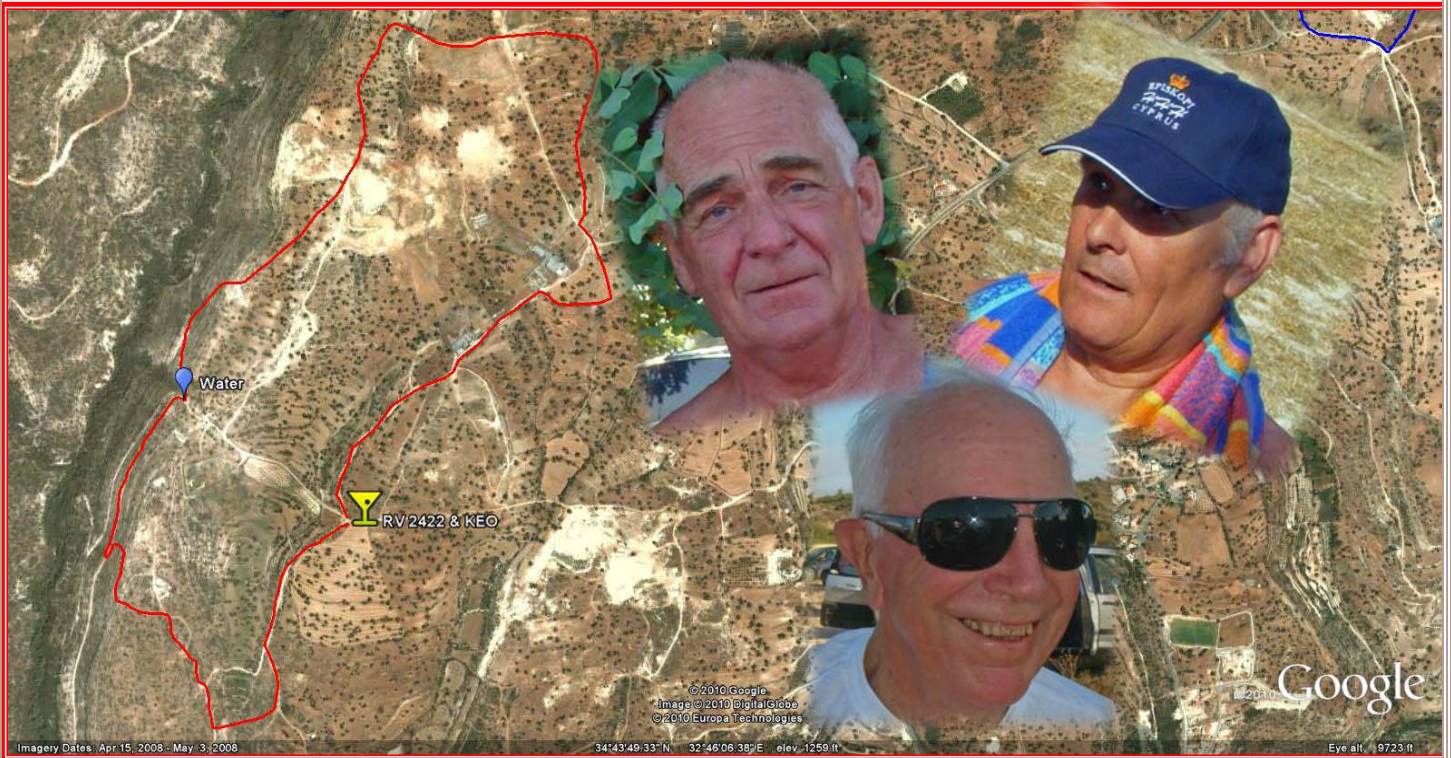
RUN 2420 - THE WELL OF THE FRANKS OPEN RUN

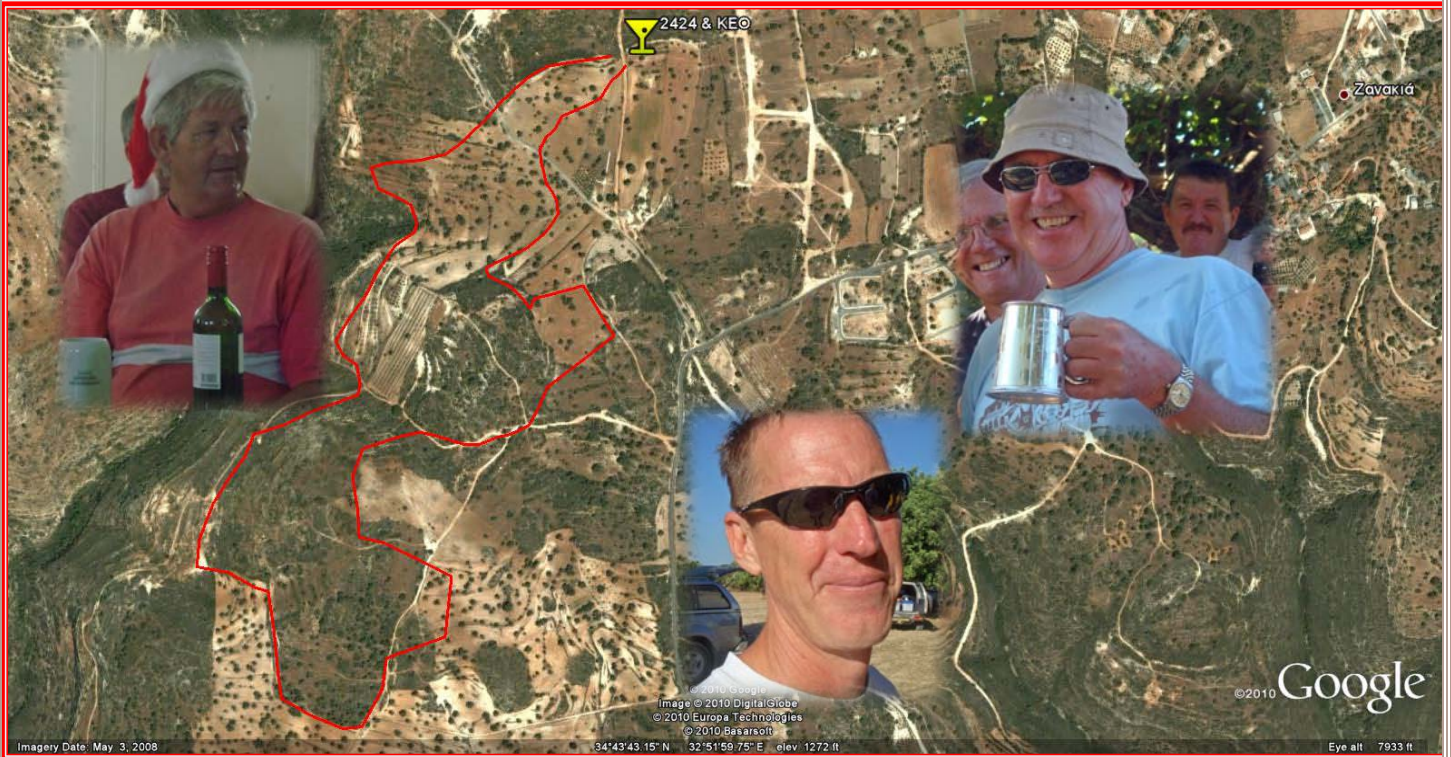

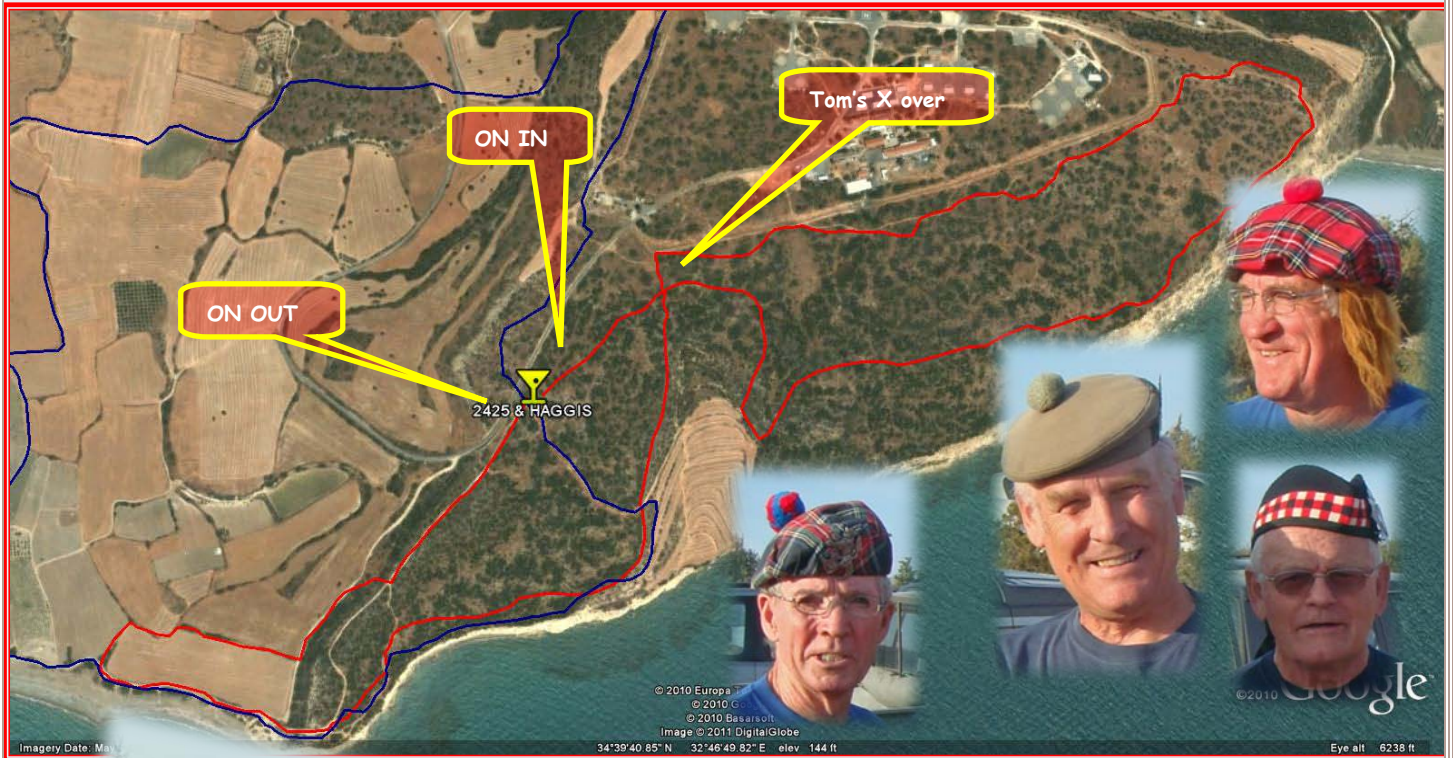

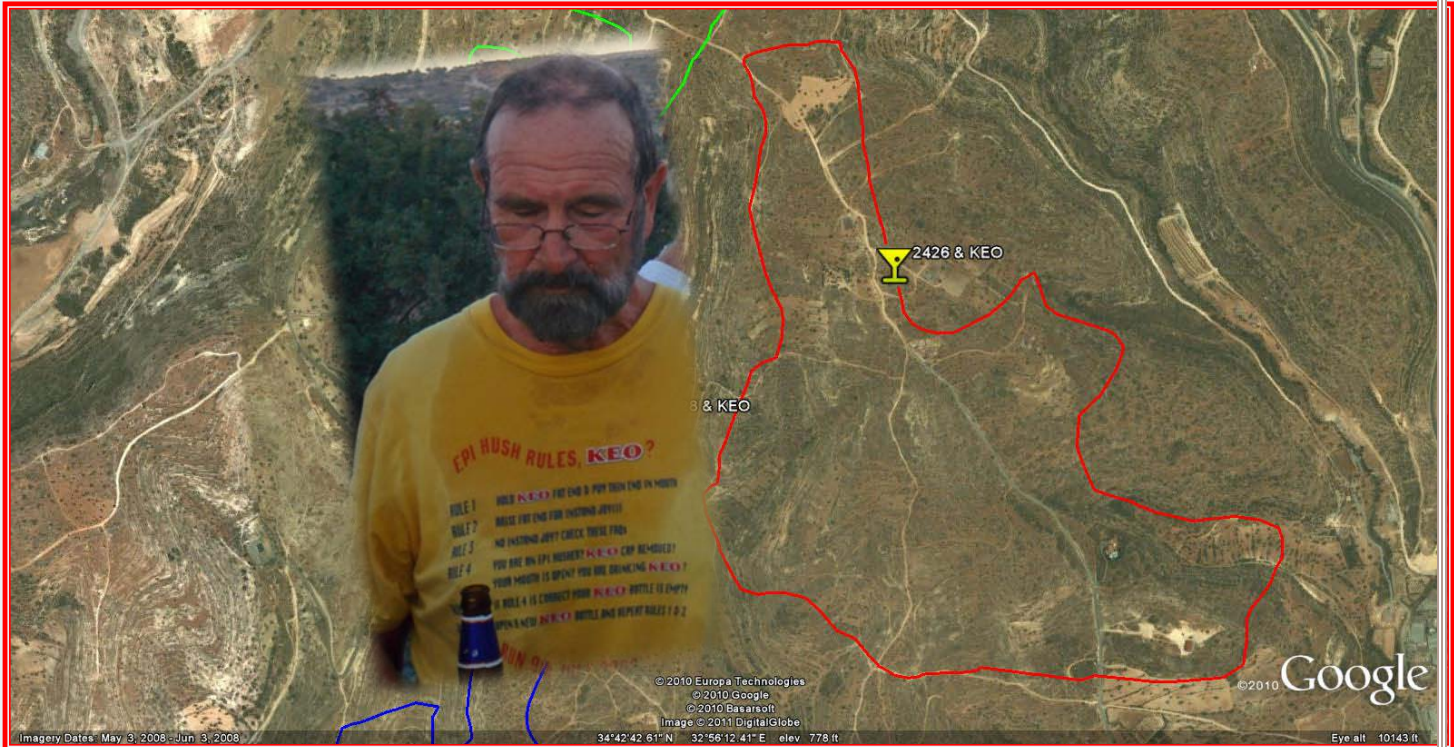

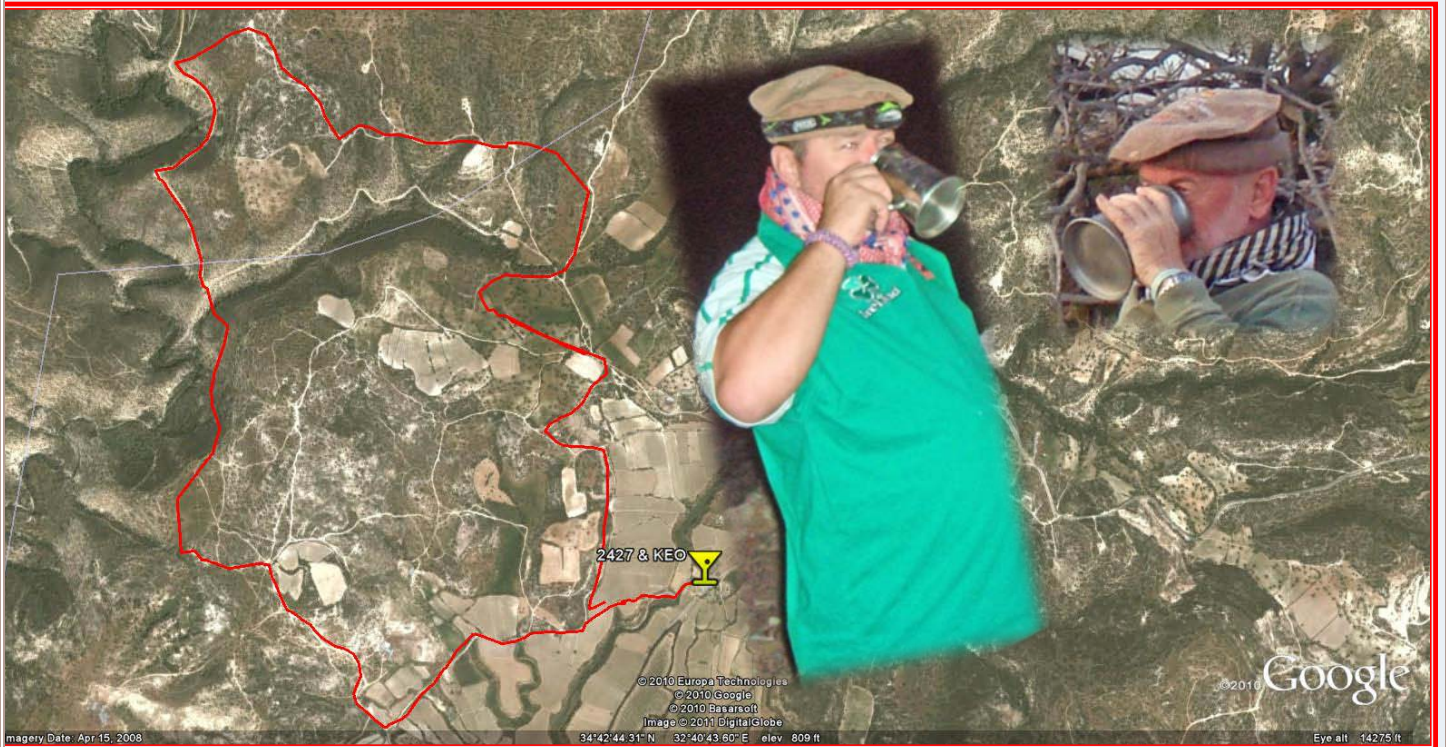
